

Beach area regulations

Beaches of the City of Järvenpää

Tervanokka Beach. Open 6:00-22:00

These regulations for the beaches have been compiled in order to ensure the safety and comfort of the users.

1. Every person under 18 years of age is under an adult's responsibility. Parents must look after their children, especially after the ones with poor swimming skills.
2. Smoking, use of alcohol/drugs or problematic behaviour resulting from the use of intoxicants is prohibited.
3. Users are under their own responsibility on the beach area. They are also responsible of their own belongings in the beach area. Found objects must be given to the lifeguard. City is not responsible of lost belongings. City is not answerable for keeping lost belongings worth less than 20€. Found belongings will be kept for 2 months, after which they will be given to the police. Valuable found belongings will be given to the police in 1 week.
4. It is recommended to use swimming shoes in the beach.
5. Fire-making and camping is prohibited.
6. Pets are not allowed in the beach area.
7. Bird feeding is prohibited.
8. Fishing and boating in the swimming area is prohibited.
9. Bringing bikes or any other vehicles to beach area is prohibited.
10. Going under platform is prohibited.
